### HOW DO I BEGIN???

1. Go to WIU homepage

3. Enter name of book in search box (choose "exact title" in drop down menu)

\*\* If the book is not in a WIU library, a message will appear saying that it doesn't exist. If this happens, click on the "***Repeat Search in the I-Share Catalog***" link.

\*\*If the book is not listed in I-share, then go back to the Library homepage (where you started your search) and click on "Worldcat." On the new Worldcat page, fill in the search box with the title of the book and choose "Title" from the drop down menu. Click on "Search" *at the bottom of the page.*
